

Setting up an EDI Trading Partner Relationship with HIBCC for HIN

This article is intended to help HIN® Authorized Licensee Users communicate electronically with HIBCC via EDI. Specifically, it provides information on how to initiate a process to receive weekly updates to the HIN database, send HIN requests to HIBCC and receive HIBCC responses to HIN requests from HIBCC. You can use this form as a worksheet, and return it to HIBCC when complete.

Transaction Set

All HIN-related messages use the ASC X.12 816 transaction set to carry the information. Templates for each transaction type can be downloaded from the HIBCC website at www.hibcc.org.

Versions

HIBCC currently supports Version 3050 only.

Application Interface

Interfacing the EDI translator to internal HIN applications is the responsibility of each Authorized Licensee User and is outside the scope of this document.

Acknowledgement Criteria

HIBCC expects to receive a functional acknowledgement (997) from an Authorized Licensee User whenever it sends an 816 message (HIN weekly update, HIBCC response to HIN request). You must inform HIBCC whether you acknowledge the document, functional groups, or interchanges (or any combination). Use the space below to indicate your acknowledgement criteria:

On inbound documents (Authorized Licensee User HIN requests), HIBCC will acknowledge functional groups only unless otherwise instructed.

Testing

After setting up a trading partner relationship, HIBCC will initiate testing by sending a HIN Weekly Update transaction. Once testing is complete on this transaction, Authorized Licensee Users can send a test HIN request to HIBCC, which HIBCC will turn around as a HIBCC response to a HIN request. The last two transactions are optional. However, Authorized Licensee Users are strongly urged to integrate all three into their internal HIN processes.

HIN Weekly Update

Weekly updates are usually transmitted at the close of business on Friday, but sometimes are delayed until the opening of business on Monday. Testing will be considered successful when the trading partner receives the 816 document, HIBCC receives the 997 acknowledgement, and both translators are able to process the messages.

Authorized Licensee User HIN Request

Authorized Licensee Users should create a single HIN request and translate it into an 816 message for transmission to HIBCC. Testing will be considered successful when HIBCC can receive and translate the 816 document, and the trading partner receives and translates the 997 acknowledgement from HIBCC.

HIBCC Response to Authorized Licensee User HIN Request

After HIBCC successfully receives an 816 Authorized Licensee User HIN Request, it will import the request into the HIN DBMS and process it (by canceling the request). It will then export the completed HIN request from the application to its translator, and will send an 816 HIBCC response transaction back to the trading partner. Testing will be considered successful when the trading partner receives the 816 document, HIBCC receives the 997 acknowledgement, and both translators are able to process the messages.

Once testing is considered complete by both parties, HIBCC will update the Authorized Licensee User's profile to "production" status, and will begin sending weekly updates on the following Friday, unless otherwise instructed.
